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## **EDUCATION AND TEXTBOOK AMOUNTS CERTIFICATE**

This form is used to certify a student's eligibility for the education and textbook amounts and to show the maximum tuition, education, and textbook amounts that a student can transfer to a designated individual. The programs described below must be taken at a designated educational institution, such as a university or college, or at an institution certified by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC). For definitions of these programs, designated educational institutions and information on the textbook amount, see pamphlet P105, Students and Income Tax.. If you took post-secondary

courses outside Canada, see Information Sheet RC192, Information for Students - Educational Institutions Outside Canada. Both of these publications are available at **www.cra.gc.ca/forms**.

To qualify for the **full-time** education amount, the student must have been enrolled in a **qualifying educational program** as a full-time student. Such a program must last at least three consecutive weeks and also require that each student spend at least 10 hours each week on course instruction or work in the program (excluding study time). Courses taken at an institution certified by HRSDC must have been to get or improve occupational skills.

To qualify for the **part-time** education amount, the student must have been enrolled in a **specified educational program**. Such a program must last at least three consecutive weeks and require a minimum of 12 hours of instruction each month on courses in the program.

A student who has a disability and is enrolled in a **qualifying educational program part-time** can claim the **full-time** rather than the **part-time** education amount if the student is entitled to the disability amount for the year **or** an authorized person certifies in Part 3 of this form or in a signed letter that, due to a mental or physical impairment, the student could not reasonably have been expected to be enrolled **full-time**.

**Do not enter the cost of textbooks on this form.** Students calculate the education **and** textbook amounts based on the number of months indicated in box B or C below. See Pamphlet P105, Students and Income Tax, at **www.cra.gc.ca/forms.**
